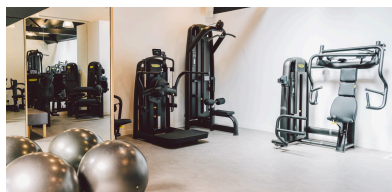

Seek out nature...

At Les Mouettes, nature will take you under its wing. In the evenings, you'll be able to listen to the waves on the beach, lulling you to sleep. The site itself is bursting with trees and shrubs, as well as flowers. You really are in the Garden of Eden!



Nature at the heart of the campsite

At our resort, nature flourishes in a harmonious landscape that's far from the traditional image of the average campsite.

Since its creation in 1972, our environmental commitment has seen annual planting of new species that has helped establish a veritable oasis on the north coast of Brittany. Among the fauna adorning our resort, the remarkable Canary palms stand out in particular, iconic symbols of our beautiful green space, nourished by the Gulf Stream's warm currents. And therein lies their secret. It hardly ever freezes here.



Thanks to the meticulous maintenance by our five-person team, guided by the expert advice of a landscape architect, each corner of our resort reserves its own trove of surprises, from majestic echiums to exotic species such as cordylines, yuccas and hydrangea paniculata grandiflora.

Wandering through our resort is akin to diving into a universe teeming with nature, where each plant tells its own story.

A bit different!

Who's ever gazed at the starry sky in the evening from their terrace and made a wish on seeing a shooting star? Did you know that a small meteorite hit the earth very near here in 1991? It was an L5 chondrite, a stony meteorite, found in Henvic. Someone who had seen a ball of fire not far from the village found it on a path, intact and with its fusion crust. It weighs 19g. More than 80,000 stones fall from space every year, and some are worth a fortune (up to 10 times the price of gold). So, keep your eyes open whenever you go for a walk! And if you find a meteorite, be careful. Wait until it cools down before you pick it up!

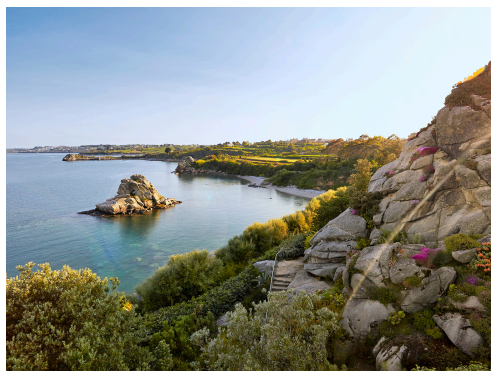

Roscoff's Exotic Gardens

No need to hop on a boat to feel like you've travelled far! For anyone suffering from seasickness and reluctant to make the trip to Batz island, Roscoff's Exotic Gardens offer a great overview of tropical species. You'll be whisked away to a tropical jungle eclipsed by an imposing granite rock. A visit is a must! And if the setting inspires you, the shop even offers plants you can take home.



Georges Delaselle Gardens

Exotic garden on Batz island. Planted in 1897 by a pioneer named Georges Delaselle. It is home to a range of species, all of which bear testament to the beneficial effects of the Gulf Stream.

Wandering through gardens and fields

Hydrangeas are a familiar sight in Carantec gardens. The colour of their flowers varies depending on the soil content and exposure to sunlight. Marvel at how their roots rub shoulders with the shale and turn blue! You'll also see magnolias, Camellias and rhododendrons that bloom once winter ends.

But the surrounding countryside is not to be outdone! The closer you get to the coastal foothills of the Leon plateau, the more artichoke fields you can see, until they appear to form a real sea of artichokes, whose waves carpet the hillsides. Originally from Italy, this thistle has found its home of choice. It is grown for its edible, succulent flower head.

Eco actions

Here are just a few easy ways to be environmentally responsible:

1. Respect the environment and protect local ecosystems: never drop litter when on a walk or at the beach. Always recycle your waste, and don't forget to take a rubbish bag when on a walk.
2. Respect the beaches: in accordance with the Department's health regulations (article 95-2), animals are not permitted on any of the beaches within the municipality.
3. To preserve the dunes and prevent their erosion, use waymarked paths and steps down to the beaches. Please park your vehicle in the designated parking spaces.
4. Do not throw your cigarette butts on the beach: one butt takes 12 years to decompose. Use a pocket ashtray; they're very useful!
5. Help us to protect our fauna and flora: the municipality is home to a number of protected natural species. When out and about, please admire the flora without picking the flowers.
6. Respect the GR34 coastal path: this path is reserved for walkers; please do not use bikes or quad bikes, etc. Our four-legged friends must be kept on a lead.

We're on board!

The Les Mouettes commitment

For several years now, we've been proud to actively support local initiatives and implement concrete actions to protect our environment. Here are some of the measures we've adopted:

1. WASTE RECYCLING

We've set up recycling points in the centre of the campsite to encourage waste separation. At the entrance of the campsite, you'll find a recycling area with two large compactors. These compactors help reduce waste volume, facilitate transport, and maintain a clean environment. Compost bins are also available to help you reduce your organic waste.

2. EXCEPTIONAL LANDSCAPED SETTING

At the heart of a region renowned for its magnificent exotic gardens, Les Mouettes stands out as the first "garden campsite", reflecting our commitment to preserving local biodiversity and giving you a superb outdoor setting.

3. WATER SAVERS

We carry out regular consumption checks, enabling us to implement practical measures such as eco-diffusers and 3/6 litre flushes in our cottages.

4. FIGHT AGAINST FOOD WASTE

We have rolled out various solutions designed to effectively reduce unconsumed products. To do this, we redistribute products to employees as well as charity organisations (Restos du Cœur, CCAS, etc.).

5. POOLS HEATED USING HEAT PUMPS

Our pools are heated using heat pumps, which helps reduce our energy consumption.

6. SOFT TRANSPORT

We have e-bikes available for you to explore Carantec. We've also installed charging points for your electric car. In summer, Carantec organises free shuttle buses that stop at the campsite and throughout the municipality.

Tidal treasures

Tides are always incredible. They can alter a landscape in just a few hours. At low tide, the beach stretches out to infinity, seemingly endlessly to the horizon, and at high tide the water ventures in as far as the seawall, bathing the sands.

This is the highest tidal coefficient of the season. The sea reaches this record level on 28 April. This spring tide will have a coefficient above 100 for four whole days! It's perfect for fishing on foot.

Chef's top tips

DIDIER BELLOUR, CHEF AT TY COZ



DIDIER places great emphasis on local products in his dishes

Moules marinières :

Wash the mussels and rinse well.
Brown the shallots or onions with garlic, thyme and bay leaves.
Add the mussels, then deglaze with white wine.
Leave covered until the mussels open.

Cooking crab:

Boil the water, coarse salt, pepper, garlic, thyme and bay leaves for 5 minutes.
Leave to simmer for 5 minutes, before infusing.
Immerse the crabs, and cook for 25 minutes. Spider crabs should be left to cook for 18 minutes.

Cooking periwinkles:

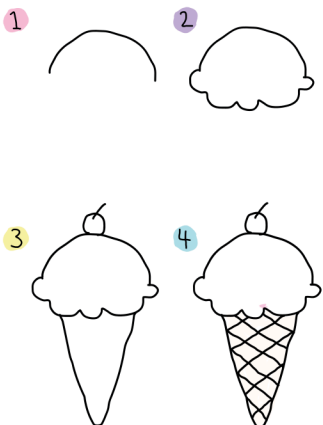
Rinse them several times.
Boil the water, coarse salt, pepper, garlic, thyme and bay leaves for 5 minutes.
Add the periwinkles, boil for 8 min, then cool the pan.
It's a good idea to retain the cooking water to keep them in.

Cooking shrimps:

Boil a large quantity of salted water (around 40g salt per litre of water).
Add the raw shrimps, stir and cover.
When the water starts to boil again, drain the shrimps.

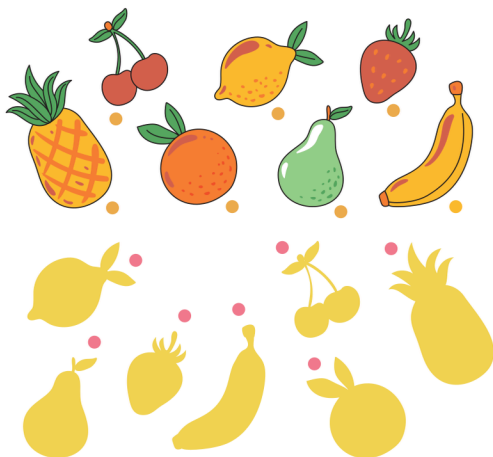

Safety rules

In life there's always a risk of the unforeseen, so here at Yelloh! Village we like to ensure holidays also mean **vigilance** 😊.

FIRE, FLOODS, STORM

Make it easier for the emergency services to do their jobs

- › Be aware of the locations of emergency exits and the routes to get there.
- › Be aware of fire extinguishing equipment and use it correctly.
- › Do not block entrances.
- › Make sure exits can be accessed.
- › Do not park your vehicle on routes which fire brigade vehicles need to use.
- › Park your caravan facing your exit point.

Prevent hazards

- › Do not smoke in areas where it is indicated that it is prohibited to do so.
- › Beware of inflammable products (use of methylated spirits or petrol is prohibited).
- › Do not tamper with heating or lighting systems, or electrical installations.
- › Campfires and barbecues (except electric and gas) are prohibited except in special areas set up for this purpose.
- › Fix and secure all equipment to the ground (caravans, awnings, tents, utensils etc.).

Instructions in the event of an emergency

- › Stay calm.
- › Inform the emergency services by dialling 112 or inform management.
- › Turn off gas supply outside and switch off electricity.
- › Leave your vehicle and camping equipment where it is.
- › Do not take refuge in caravans (in the event of severe flooding and coastal storms, these can be washed away or blown away).
- › Go to the nearest emergency exit.



FOR ALL EMERGENCIES DIAL 112

The evacuation plan applicable in the event of a fire, storm or flood alert can be found in the vicinity of all communal amenities in the village.

Work out your route to the emergency exits straight away:



If you hear the alarm signal, evacuate the area immediately!

Mon bracelet LM Pass

Shops and services on the site only accept payment by card and LM Pass. Want to use cash to pay for your purchases? It couldn't be easier! Just load your LM Pass wristband at reception or the tourist information point.

The **LM PASS** gives you peace of mind for the whole of your holiday. No more checkout headaches, like having to make sure you always have enough cash in your wallet or rummaging for your debit card at the bottom of your bag, only to realise you've left it back in your accommodation... The LM PASS is a wristband, incorporating a secure chip, that goes wherever you do, even to the beach or the pool! It enables you to pay for anything you buy at any time of day. **Try it, you'll love it!**

What is the LM PASS wristband?

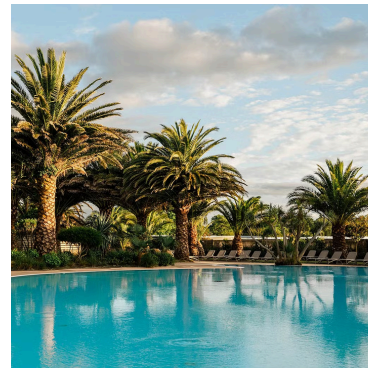

At any of the resort's sales outlets: reception, snack stalls, bars, mini market, restaurant, tourist information point.

What do I do if I have no more credit on my LM Pass wristband?

You can load up your wristband at any credit loading point during opening hours, or at any time on les-mouettes.camping-cashless.com

I have credit left on my LM Pass wristband at the end of my holiday. What should I do?

Go to les-mouettes.camping-cashless.com to request a refund of your remaining credit. You will be refunded within a few days by bank transfer.

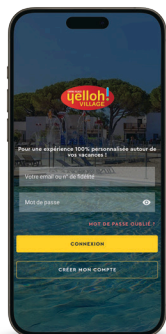
