And to extend the experience, a new sensory space dedicated to relaxation and wellbeing will be available from 2026.



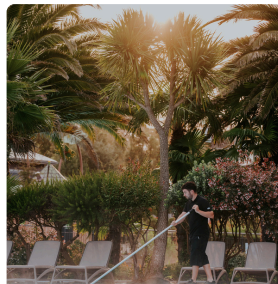
Le Lagon

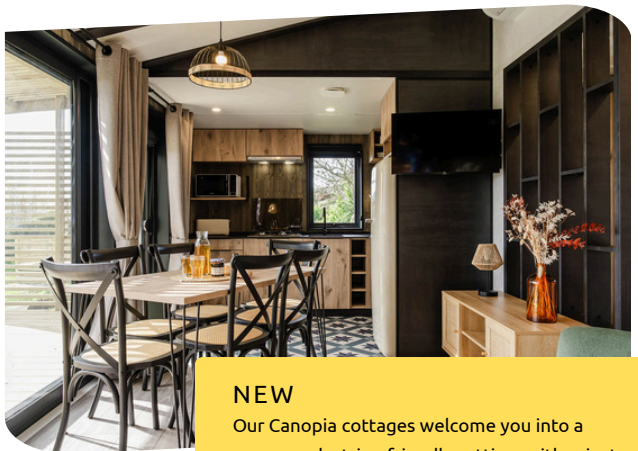

Let nature take over...

At Les Mouettes, nature gently takes you under its wing. Across the site, lush vegetation shapes the landscape and creates a unique atmosphere. In the evening, the sound of the waves drifts in from the distance, softly accompanying the end of the day. It almost feels like a garden of Eden.



Nature at the heart of the campsite

Here, nature does more than simply surround the campsite: it is an integral part of it. Since 1972, it has been carefully nurtured, enriched and shaped to create a lush environment in harmony with the Breton coast.

Over the years, thousands of plant species have been introduced. Palms, cordylines, echiums, yuccas and hydrangeas now shape a unique setting, where Breton influences blend with more exotic touches. The mild climate, shaped by the Gulf Stream, allows this vegetation to thrive.

Behind this balance lies the work of a passionate team, who care for, plant and develop the site throughout the seasons. Every path, every corner holds its share of discoveries. Behind each flower bed lies a new atmosphere.

Taking the time to wander through the campsite also means observing, breathing, and letting yourself be carried by this nature, which is truly part of the experience.



A surprising story

Who has never gazed up at the starry sky from their terrace in the evening and made a wish upon a shooting star?

Did you know that not far from here, a small meteorite fell in 1991?

It is an L5 chondrite, a stony meteorite discovered in Henvic. Its finder, who had seen a fireball near the village, discovered it on a path, intact, with its fusion crust. It weighs just 19 grams. These stones from space fall to Earth in their tens of thousands every year, and some are worth a fortune (up to ten times the price of gold).

So next time you're out for a walk, keep your eyes open! And if you do find a meteorite... be careful: wait until it has cooled down before picking it up!

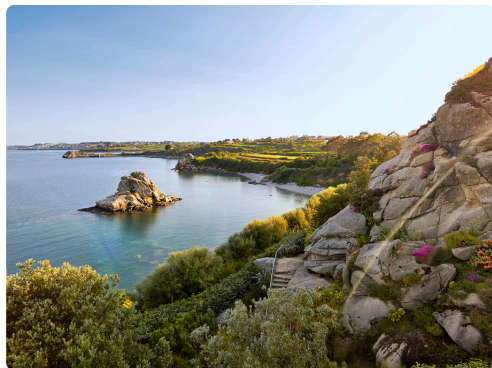

Roscoff Exotic Garden

No need to take a boat to feel a change of scenery! For those who get seasick or prefer to skip a trip to the island of Batz, Roscoff's Exotic Garden offers a wonderful glimpse of tropical plants. You'll feel transported into a lush jungle, dominated by an impressive granite rock.

A visit is a must! And if the setting inspires you, there's even a shop where you can take a few plants home.



Georges Delaselle Garden

An exotic garden on the island of Batz, founded in 1897 by the pioneer Georges Delaselle. Here, you can discover a wide variety of plant species, all reflecting the beneficial influence of the Gulf Stream.



Wandering through gardens and fields

Hydrangeas are the emblematic plants of Carantec's gardens. The colour of their flowers varies depending on the soil and exposure. When their roots grow in slate-rich soil, they turn beautifully blue! You'll also see magnolias, camellias and rhododendrons, which bloom at the end of winter.

The surrounding countryside is just as striking. As you approach the final coastal slopes of the Léon plateau, artichoke fields become more and more common, eventually forming a true sea of artichokes, their waves rolling across the hills... Originally from Italy, this thistle has found its perfect home here. It is grown for its flower bud, which is delicious.

Eco-friendly tips

Here are a few simple ways to help protect the environment:

1. Respect the environment and protect local ecosystems: never leave any litter behind when out walking or at the beach. Continue to sort your waste and feel free to bring a rubbish bag with you on your outings.
2. Respect the beaches: in accordance with local regulations, animals are not allowed on the beaches in the area.
3. Protect the dunes and prevent erosion: use marked paths and steps to access the beaches. Please park your vehicle in designated parking areas.
4. Do not throw cigarette butts on the beach: a single cigarette butt can take up to 12 years to decompose. Use a pocket ashtray, it's very practical!
5. Help protect wildlife and plant life: the area is home to many protected species. During your walks, admire the plants without picking the flowers.
6. Respect the GR34 coastal path: this path is reserved for pedestrians, so please do not use bicycles, quad bikes, etc. Our four-legged friends must be kept on a lead.

For several years, we have been proud to support local initiatives and take concrete action to protect our environment. Here are some of the steps we have taken.

SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES

To encourage recycling, waste sorting points are available in the centre of the village, as well as a recycling area at the entrance to the campsite. Equipped with compactors, it helps reduce the volume of waste and makes processing easier. Compost bins are also available to help limit organic waste. As part of the same approach, we heat the pools in the water park using heat pumps in order to reduce energy consumption.

BIODIVERSITY

At the heart of a region renowned for its magnificent exotic gardens, Les Mouettes is known as the first "garden campsite", reflecting our commitment to preserving local biodiversity and offering you an enchanting natural setting.

RESPONSIBLE TOURISM

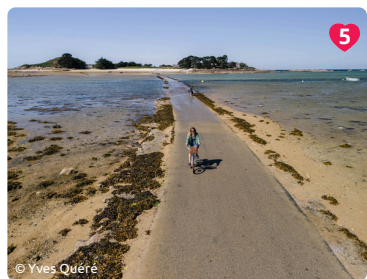
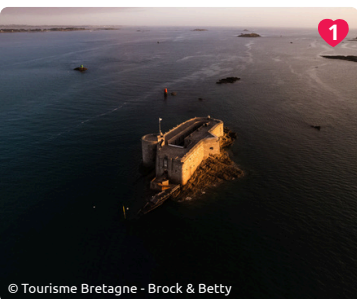
We offer standard and electric bikes for hire, so you can explore Carantec and the surrounding area. Four charging points for electric vehicles (22 kW) are also available on the campsite. During the summer, free shuttle buses run throughout the town of Carantec and stop at the campsite, making it easier to get around.

SUPPORTING OTHERS

We have put in place practical solutions to reduce surplus products. They are redistributed to our staff and to local charities (such as Restos du Cœur and the CCAS). We also support local associations (such as La Vie en Rose and l'Estivale), schools and local producers.

9. Follow in the footsteps of the corsairs in Roscoff, a charming little town full of character

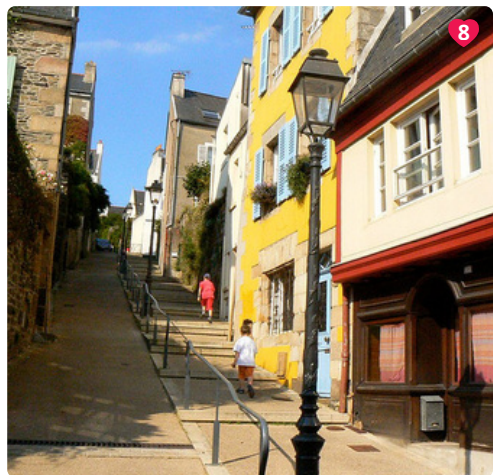

Treasures of the tides

Tides are that little detail that completely transforms the landscape within just a few hours. At low tide, vast open spaces stretch as far as the eye can see, while at high tide, the sea returns right up to the seawalls and washes over the beaches.

The number:

102

This is the highest tidal coefficient of the season, expected on 14 August. For three days, tidal coefficients will rise above 100, creating ideal conditions for shore fishing.

A little fishing guide

Here are a few tips for enjoying shore fishing while respecting the natural environment:

- a fishing rod: sea bass, mackerel
- an old sickle: sand eels
- a landing net: prawns, sea catfish (not edible)
- a Swiss army knife: mussels, wild oysters
- plenty of patience: lobster
- a sturdy pair of gloves: velvet crabs
- a wetsuit and snorkel: spider crabs, edible crabs
- a wetsuit and scuba tanks: John Dory, sole, conger eel, sea bass, red mullet...

The Chef's Tips

DIDIER BELLOUR, CHEF AT TY COZ



In his kitchen, **Didier** gives pride of place to local produce.

Moules marinières:

1. Wash and rinse the mussels thoroughly.
2. Sauté the shallots or onions with the garlic, thyme and bay leaves.
3. Add the mussels, then pour in the white wine.
4. Cover and cook until the mussels have opened.

Cooking brown crab and spider crab:

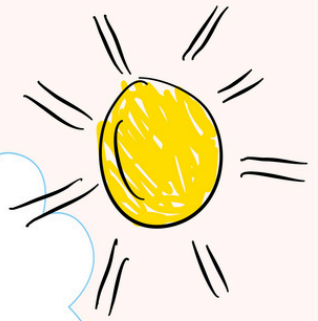
1. Bring water to the boil with coarse salt, pepper, garlic, thyme and bay leaves.
2. Leave to simmer for 5 minutes, allowing the flavours to infuse well.
3. Add the brown crabs and cook for 25 minutes. For spider crabs, cook for 18 minutes.

Cooking winkles:

1. Rinse the winkles several times.
2. Bring water to the boil with coarse salt, pepper, garlic, thyme and bay leaves for 5 minutes.
3. Add the winkles and boil for 8 minutes, then cool the pot down.
4. Keep the cooking water to store them in. They taste even better that way.

Cooking brown shrimp:

1. Bring a large volume of salted water to the boil (around 40 g of salt per litre of water).
2. Add the raw shrimp, stir and cover.
3. As soon as the water comes back to the boil, drain the shrimp.

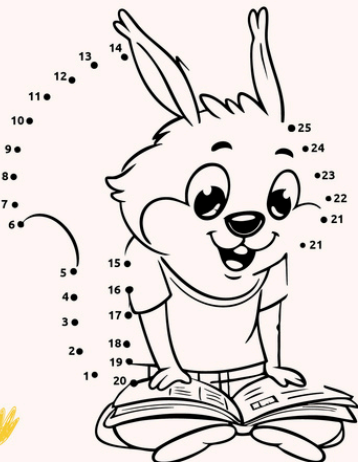

MAKE IT EASIER FOR THE EMERGENCY SERVICES TO DO THEIR JOBS

- Be aware of the locations of emergency exits and the routes to get there.
- Be aware of fire extinguishing equipment and use it correctly.
- Do not block entrances.
- Make sure exits can be accessed.
- Do not park your vehicle on routes which fire brigade vehicles need to use.
- Park your caravan facing your exit point.

PREVENT HAZARDS

- Do not smoke in areas where it is indicated that it is prohibited to do so.
- Beware of inflammable products (use of methylated spirits or petrol is prohibited).
- Do not tamper with heating or lighting systems, or electrical installations.
- Campfires and barbecues (except electric and gas) are prohibited except for in special areas set up for this purpose.
- Fix and secure all equipment to the ground (caravans, awnings, tents, utensils etc.).

FOR ALL EMERGENCIES, DIAL **112**

The evacuation plan applicable in the event of a fire, storm or flood alert can be found in the vicinity of all communal amenities in the village.



Work out your route to the emergency exits straight away: If you hear the alarm signal, evacuate the area immediately!

INSTRUCTIONS IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY

- Stay calm.
- Inform the emergency services by dialling 112 or inform management.
- Turn off gas supply outside and switch off electricity.
- Leave your vehicle and camping equipment where it is.
- Do not take refuge in caravans (in the event of severe flooding and coastal storms, these can be washed away or blown away).
- Go to the nearest emergency exit.

My LM Pass wristband

Payments in the shops and services across the campsite can only be made by bank card or with the LM Pass.

Would you like to pay in cash?

Simply top up your LM Pass wristband at reception or at the tourist information point.

The LM Pass is a secure wristband that goes wherever you go, from the beach to the pool. It lets you pay for your purchases easily throughout the day, without ever needing to take out your wallet.



Your electronic wallet

The LM Pass wristband works like an electronic wallet: simply top it up and use it at the resort's points of sale.

Manage my cashless account

Is it easy to create my account?

A few days before your arrival, you will receive an EasyTransac email with your login details and a link to access your account (les-mouettes.cashless.fr). Everything is designed to help you create your account in just a few clicks and easily find all your wristbands.

You can also access your account via the **Yelloh! Village app**.

Go to the "Services" section, then click on "LM Pass wristband": you'll find everything you need to access your account there.

Is it mandatory?

No, it isn't. You can top up your wristband directly at Reception or the Tourist Information Point. The portal is a convenient service, but it is entirely optional.

What is the cashless account portal for?

From this portal, you can:

- Top up your wristbands
- Track your spending and remaining balance
- Transfer money from one wristband to another (for guests staying together)
- Block a wristband in case of loss or theft
- Request a refund for any unused credit

Gentle ways to get around

How about hiring a bike?
